September 8, 2025**

Mayor Roger Meinert called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M. in Council Chambers, 227 E. Lincoln Avenue, Reed City, Michigan.

Present Roger Meinert, Trevor Guiles, Nicole Woodside, and Brad Nixon. James Anderlohr arrived at 5:38. Charles Lupo, and Nate Bailey were absent. Also in attendance; City Treasurer, Kadee Kidd, Fire Chief Jeff Stein and Waste Water Treatment Plant Supervisor, Curt Brackenrich and City Clerk, Amanda Grant. The meeting was opened with the pledge to the flag. There were citizens in the audience.
