REGULAR PLANNING COMMISSION  
June 2, 2014**

Jim Murnik called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. in Council Chambers, 227 East Lincoln Avenue, Reed City, Michigan.

- Present:** Jim Murnik, Karen Crosson, Bonnie Danziesen, Janet Campau, Marlene Fatum, Trevor Guiles, Randy Laramore, Dawn Montague and Ron Howell. Trisha Wirth was in the audience. The meeting was opened with the pledge to the flag.
- Agenda** Motion by Guiles, seconded by Campau, **CARRIED**, to approve the agenda as presented. Affirmed voice vote.
- Minutes** Motion by Fatum, seconded by Guiles, **CARRIED**, to accept the minutes of the May 5, 2014 regular meeting. Affirmed voice vote.
- Public Comment** Trisha Wirth, member of the Little League Board, inquired what is going to be done with the Westerburg Park ball fields. She was told there was recreational funds available and that the ball fields were on for discussion at the Planning Meeting. Trisha explained the Little League has invested a lot of money in the small ball field and recently purchased the yellow cap along the fences as it is a requirement in Little League if you are going to host any tournaments. She advised member that the bases at the Little League field need to be updated as a safety issue. They are not a requirement yet, but need to be “break away” bases. Ron would like to coordinate everything going on at Westerburg Park with Little League, Softball League and whoever is using the City facilities there so everyone understands what each is doing. Trisha agreed to email Ron and setup a meeting.
- Recreation** Members rated their top 10 recreational projects/objectives and turned them in to Ron Howell to calculate the results. Dawn and Marlene reported the benches down on the linear trail by the river are broken and need to be removed before someone tries to use them and gets hurt.
- Zoning** Zoning Administrator had no zoning matters to report other than he had received preliminary plans for a small expansion project at Pizza Hut which the site plan review will probably be on the agenda for the July planning meeting.
