**City Manager:** Rich Saladin reported on the following:

- Disc golf had a clean-up at the park and made great strides with over 25 people helping. Another clean-up is scheduled for July.
- Dan Burchett reported plans of Dog park moving to the south part of Westerburg Park; across the street from Moose Lodge is moving ahead with the planning stages.
- Art in Park had a wonderful turn out and was really well done.
- Friday night music Showcase starts June 24, 2022. The City of Reed City received a grant from OCCF for support of Art In The Park and support the following: Roosevelt Diggs playing on 7/30/22. There will be John Cougar Mellencamp tribute band, Chainsaw Carving and Ventriloquist show all at the Reed City Depot.
- The City applied for a grant last year through clean water state revolving fund and are continuing the process and looking for different grants to make this project go.
- Public hearing on June 20, 2022 on Drinking Water grant application through Fleis. Council will then vote for going forward on the grant for the new well, water main replacement on East Todd and lead line replacement support. This would 3.5 million project and hope to be a 60% grant.
- Taking a proposal to council for trail system on June 20, 2022 meeting and Veteran's Memorial park will be incorporated.
- Trees replacement at Rambadt Park and Liner Park Trail. Applied for grants and received grants for grinding of stumps and planting 26 trees.
