1) January

- a) Recommended to City Council the adoption of an ordinance allowing Adult Day Care Centers as Principle Uses Allowed By Right in C-1, C-2, and C-3 zoning districts.

2) February

- a) Approved Site Plan for Chestnut Storage at 853 S Chestnut St

3) March

- a) Recommended to City Council the adoption of an ordinance prohibiting Marihuana establishments in all zoning districts.
- b) Requested examples of interactive trail maps as proposed by Fleis & Vandenbrink.
- c) A discussion was established regarding the creation of an ice-skating rink, kayak launch site, and Veteran's park. This discussion was to take place monthly until resolved.

4) April

- a) Discussed the promotion of Reed City as an "all-season tourism" destination.
- b) Recommended to City Council the Capital Improvements Program for 2019-2020 budget year.
- c) Recommended to City Council to apply for a \$40,000 MSHDA grant.
